CROSS-REFERENCES

FLAG SOP-QA-114 cited at two revisions

ABBREVIATIONS

REVIEW "LIMS" is never expanded

SCREENED AGAINST

Criteria referencing **21 CFR Part 211**, **21 CFR Part 11**, and **EU GMP** — human-authored, never model-generated.

Built with a QA manager mid-BLA — for the people who do this by hand.

SCREENS EVERY DOCUMENT FOR

Inspection criteria Data integrity
 Cross-document Figures & signatures
 Abbreviations Cross-references Dates

THREE VERDICTS, PER CRITERION

FLAG A clear, specific problem
REVIEW Not enough to judge — your call
PASS No issue against this criterion

No overall verdict. No score. No "ready to submit."
